Significance and Contribution

Approximately 4 million years ago, the human species was in its infancy. Following weather patterns, we were nomadic and depended greatly upon our innate survival skills and protective instincts. It wasn't until about 10,000 years ago, with the advent of agriculture, the first human civilizations began to take shape. Food became easier to acquire, walls protected the tribes, and weapons ensured the survivability and abundance for the community from which they were fashioned. It was as though, all of a sudden, 6 million years of ancestral instinctive human evolution had come to a halt. All of our habits and patterns of survival in the threatening physical world of predator versus prey were no longer actually needed, at least not to the same degree. This sudden shift in the safety and predictability of human civilization gave rise to a new adaptation, though this time it would not be a genetic alteration providing us with longer fingers, or larger eyes, or aquatic gills. No, this time the mutation would be of the mind, in the collective consciousness of the human organism, we could call it - civilized psychology.
